REQUIREMENTS TO THE MATERIALS

Font: Times New Roman 14 pt, spacing - 1,5, margins - 20mm on all sides

Typography: full name, scientific degree, academic status, place of work, e-mail of the author should be printed in the top right corner.

UDC: should be printed in the top left corner.

Name of the report (article): in the middle of the page (all capital letters, bold font, Times New Roman 14 pt).

Summary: up to five lines in Ukrainian, Russian and English.

Size: 2-3 pages for thesis and 6-8 pages for an article (as an exception up to 15 pages).

After the conference the issue of collection of the thesis of the reports is planned as well publishing of articles in a professional journal.

FINANCE CONDITIONS

Registration fee for participation of the conference is **300 UAH** (40 USD).

Publishing a page in the collection of the thesis of the reports – **105 UAH** (10 USD) (TBC). Publishing a page of text articles – **35 UAH** (3 USD) (TBC).

Participants will pay for their travel and stay. All participants will be provided with accommodation in the hostel of the institute.

The cost of living is **100 UAH** (13 USD) **per night** (rooms at the hotel can also be booked).

The cost of three meals a day is **80 UAH** (10 USD) **per night**.
